



Marine Corps League #942 Continues to Ship Packages Congratulations!

PACKAGES SHIPPED TO DATE: 6,492 - approximately 85,600 lbs. 90% of the packages are being shipped to the troops in Afghanistan, a much more rugged place than Iraq, with little of the same access to basic hygiene items. 
