Most of us know the story of

...the "Doolittle Raid".

Thursday we have a very special opportunity to learn even more!

PHIL LANCASTER

President of the Jimmy Doolittle Air & Space Museum at Travis AFB

Four months after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, Lieutenant Colonel Jimmy Doolittle and his squadron of 16 B-25 bombers, manned by all volunteers, took off, secretly, from the USS Hornet and bombed their targets of Tokyo, Kobe, Yokohama, Osaka, and Nagoya. Knowing they lacked enough fuel to reach a safe airbase, Doolittle and the majority of his men bailed out over China and were rescued by Chinese guerrilla fighters. All the planes were lost as well as seven crew members.

While the "Doolittle Raid" did minor damage to the Japanese towns, this was seen as a major moralebuilding victory for the United States. The raid had shown the Japanese that their homeland was vulnerable to air attack, and forced then to re-direct a portion of their firepower to homeland defense, leading directly to the decisive American victory during the Battle of Midway.

What you probably did not know:

Doolittle was a local boy, having been born in Alameda, and attended UC Berkeley

He was a high speed test pilot

Most famous for his development of instrument flying

Realized that pilots had to be trained to "trust their instruments"

Fought in Mexican Border Service, WWI, WWII Pacific, Mediterranean, and European Campaign as well as the Korean War

Had a long career with Shell Oil

Reached the rank of Four Star General

Died in 1993 at Pebble Beach, CA

These are just a few of the many fascinating facts and stories about **Jimmy Doolittle**.

VNVDV Veterans Plan Return to VietNam in 2012



VNVDV Return to Vietnam, 2012

Plans for the **Viet Nam Veterans of Diablo Valley's** (VNVDV), November 2012, return to Vietnam are well underway. We will once again partner with the **Wheelchair Foundation** on this journey, to distribute approximately 250 wheel chairs to those in need, at pre-screened agencies throughout Vietnam.

The tentative timeframe for this trip is **November 4 to 21, 2012**. We expect the cost for this trip, to be approximately **\$3,000 to \$3,500**, per person, when finalized. The cost of the trip may be tax deductible, as we will be on a volunteer, charitable mission in conjunction with the **Wheelchair Foundation**. Please consult your tax adviser for further details.

There will be space available for **20** to make the journey. Since space will be limited, if there are more than 20 who wish to make the trip, some criteria will be set to determine travel priority. An initial deposit of **\$1,000**, **per individual**, will also be required when plans are finalized..

The following areas are being considered for this trip, so that those wishing to visit locations where they served, during the War, may do so: Saigon (Ho Chi Minh City), Can Tho, Quy Nhon, Hue, Ha Long Bay and Hanoi.

The **2012** trip will be the **VNVDV**'s **second return to Vietnam**. In 2006, nine (9) VNVDV members and their spouses/significant others made the memorable journey. Everyone who made this trip in 2006, felt that it not only helped the veterans, but also dramatically improved the life of those who received a wheelchair, as well as their caregivers and families.

During the 2006 journey, impromptu "group sessions" were held to discuss veterans' memories, feelings, and observations. More importantly, spouses/significant others were involved in many of these discussions, contributing to the healing experience of any leftover war time issues.

Additional trip details will be forthcoming, as plans and itinerary are finalized. Tours aboard the Battleship USS IOWA BB-61

We wanted to let your group know that **Battleship USS IOWA** is open for tours on the weekends for a brief period of time at Pier 3 at the Port of Richmond before our departure to Los Angeles.

Pacific Battleship Center, the non-profit organization that is bringing **USS IOWA** back to life is hosting the "Battleship Expo at the Port of Richmond." The "expo" includes a visit on board **USS IOWA** and access to exhibits that include a short film on the battleship, 16" shells, a Sheridan tank & half-track displayed by the **Military Vehicle Foundation**, the Blue Angels F-4 Phantom flight simulator from Pacific Coast Air Museum, and numerous other exhibits. The "Battleship Expo" entrance donation is \$10 per adult, \$5 per child 12 years or older, and children 11 & under are free.

Currently the forward portion of the main deck with a view of turrets 1 & 2 is open to guests. As work is completed, additional exhibits and areas on the battleship may be open to the public for visitation. It is encouraged to return to see the progress.

Reservations are not required. **USS IOWA** is located at Terminal 3 - 1411 Harbour Way - Richmond CA. The "Battleship Expo" can be accessed via the northeast gate on Saturdays and Sundays during the hours of 10am to 4pm.




