The Wheelchair Foundation's VNVDV VietNam Revisit - November 2012

Plans for the VNVDV's 2012 return trip to Vietnam will be shared and discussed at our March 1st dinner meeting. A 25 minute video, documenting our 2006 trip, produced by Charter Member, Dennis Marguet, will be shown during our meeting, in lieu of a guest speaker.

The group will depart from San Francisco for Vietnam on November 3rd or 4th, 2012 and depart Hanoi, Vietnam, November 18, 2012, arriving back at San Francisco, November 19th or 20th. Departure time and return time will be dictated by the airline schedule. It is critical, for the continued planning of this trip that we know the number of VNVDV members and their traveling companions, that intend to join us

As in our previous trip, we intend to travel with the **Wheelchair Foundation** and distribute wheelchairs throughout Vietnam. The trip will be approximately \$3,000 to \$3,500. This includes airfare, hotel accommodations, some/all meals and in-country transportation. This cost does not include any side trips that individuals may wish to make on their own.

Current plans include Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon), Can Tho (Mekong Delta), Da Nang, Hue, Ha Long Bay, and Hanoi. Side trips may be planned from these locations. More information on arranging side trips will follow, once travelers are identified and your intentions are known.

Interested VNVDV travelers are asked to make an initial deposit of \$1,000. per individual. Checks only, please. Make checks out to <u>VNVDV</u>, note, for Vietnam trip and mail to P.O. Box 2079, Danville, CA 94526. Once again, we are making this request - to aid the WCF and to finalize our plans for this trip. Additional trip details will be forthcoming, as we begin to receive reservation commitments and the itinerary is finalized.

Have You attended a Welcome Home?

ITH a rumbling roar, 30 motorcycles ridden by tough, hard-bitten bikers pull up to an airport curbside with lights flashing and flags rippling in the breeze to greet an unsuspecting soldier returning from Iraq or Afghanistan.

"Welcome home, brother!" bellows Fred "Spike" Schau, cheering and waving the Stars and Stripes. "We want you to know we appreciate what

you've done."

The raucous scene has been repeated hundreds of times in the last two years by the Oakland-based bikers group Warriors' Watch. Founded by Schau, an active Navy reservist with 18 years' service, the organization is dedicated to making sure that Iraq and Afghanistan vets get a happier welcome home than their Vietnam counterparts.

"During Vietnam, our soldiers came home to protests – some were even spit on," Schau told The ENQUIRER. "We learned a hard lesson. These vets are our children, our neighbors, our brothers and sisters, who are doing their duty for America. We need to let them know that they are loved and their mission is appreciated.

"That's why we ride."

And ride they do - over 300 bikers

from Warriors' Watch have provided more than 700 escort rides to soldiers returning from Afghanistan and Iraq. They coordinate with families and meet the surprised warriors at airports or restaurants, providing a "rolling thunder" accompaniment to their triumphant return home.

WARRIORS' WATCH HELPS ORGANIZE

gala receptions, often featuring local politicians, police and firefighters – all there to greet and applaud military heroes who have served their country.

Sadly, they also perform another duty
- escorting the hearses of those who
made the ultimate sacrifice. Sometimes
they function as pallbearers and have
even provided send-off rifle volleys.

"These men have given everything they have to our country," explained Schau. "It's up to us to make sure they know that their sacrifices will never be forgotten."

Schau, who's been named Veteran of the Year for his district, has racked up more than 120,000 miles on his Harley-Davidson Electra Glide Classic motorcycle in service to veterans. When he's not riding, he saddles up to his computer to maintain the organization's website – www.warriorswatch.org – keeping track of members in 38 states.

The group, which accepts no donations, makes 15 to 20 trips per month, and not all are on motorcycles. Scooters, three-wheelers and cars have also joined the cavalcade.

"It's really a sight to see when we welcome a vet home," Schau, 52, told The ENQUIRER. "It makes it all worthwhile to see the smiles on their faces. They know we love and honor them - that's what counts."



Free Tax Help for Military Personnel & their Families

Free tax return preparation assistance is available for eligible military members and their spouses. The IRS and U.S. Armed Forces participate in the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program, which provides free tax advice, tax preparation, return filing and other tax assistance to military members and their families.

Here are five things you need to know about free military tax assistance:

- 1. Armed Forces Tax Council The Armed Forces Tax Council oversees the operation of the military tax programs worldwide, conducting outreach with the IRS to military personnel and their families. The AFTC consists of tax program coordinators for the Marine Corps, Air Force, Army, Navy and Coast Guard.
- 2. Volunteer tax sites Volunteer assistors at military-based VITA sites are trained to address military-specific tax issues, such as combat zone tax benefits and the Earned Income Tax Credit guidelines.
- 3. What to bring To receive free tax assistance, bring the following records to your military VITA site:
- Valid photo identification
- Social Security cards for you, your spouse & dependents or a Social Security number verification letter issued by the Social Security Administration.
- Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents
- Wage and earning statement(s) like Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R
- Interest and dividend statements (Forms 1099)
- A copy of last year's federal and state tax returns, if available
- · Checkbook for routing and account numbers for direct deposit
- Total amount paid for day care and day care provider's identifying number
- Other relevant information about income and expenses
- **4.** Joint returns If your filing status is Married Filing Jointly and you wish to file your tax return electronically, both you and your spouse should be present to sign the required forms. If it isn't possible for both of you to be present, a valid power of attorney that allows tax preparation can be used to sign and file the return.
- **5.** Special exception There is a special exception to using a power of attorney for spouses in combat zones. The exception allows the filing spouse to e-file a joint return with only a written statement stating the other spouse is in a combat zone and unable to sign.


