

- March 6<sup>th</sup> : **Douglas Northam USN** will describe what it took to survive the three years he spent as a Japanese POW during WWII. Douglas details the horrors of daily life in the many camps he spent time in and the excitement of finally being liberated.
- **April 3<sup>rd</sup>: John Shirley-WWII** 3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Division of the US Army, awarded the Bronze Star, Purple Heart as well as being named to the French Legion of Honor. He will tell of his combat on the breakout of the Anzio, Italy Beachhead, and the march to capture Rome. Also how he was wounded, captured, and escaped fighting in the Colmar Pocket, France.

After the war he was<br/>drafted and sent to Occupied Japan as an interpreter. Later Tad had a reward-<br/>ing career at Lawrence Livermore Labs for over 35 years.
- June 5th :Susan Mayall Grew up in England during World War II. Having lost<br/>her father to the war, her mother was left with four small children, Susan at six,<br/>being the eldest. She will describe how they survived the nightly bombing,<br/>strict rationing, travel restrictions, and constant air raids.

As you know, many parents have never had such an opportunity; a mother whose son died just ten months ago never felt comfortable enough to speak about his death, yet told her story to VNVDV member John Reese and others for the very first time. Mothers and fathers attend together and alone, some knowing not a soul, but bravely come to honor their sons' and daughters' memories at Friday's Memorial Service that exquisitely honors both parents and their sons and daughters, speaking each name, displaying every face, recognizing all with lighted candles and white roses.





## VA is working with Equine-Assisted Therapy Group for Veterans - *Program Started contact directly*



#### EQUINE-ASSISTED THERAPY GROUP FOR VETERANS

Giant Steps Therapeutic equestrian Center is currently offering a six-week equine-assisted psychotherapy group for Veterans who are experiencing issues related to combat trauma. This group will help Veterans to recognize and manage anger and other intense emotions they may be experiencing since returning home and dealing with the transition from combat soldier to civilian. Our group will offer participants a hands-on experience with horses to help them engage in their own healing process. Horses have an unique ability to help people work through traumas and emotional harriers without shame or stigma. Being naturally in the moment and present, horses provide meaningful and long lasting educational opportunities through metaphorical learning experiences. Dr. Roberson and her team will put the horses' unique sensitivities to work and by using their special capacity to read and respond to people's non-verbal signals and cues, provide opportunities for powerful emotional breakthroughs and life-changing insights helping the participant to reconnect with aspects of themselves and their lives. This is a ground-based non-riding program, no previous horse experience necessary!

cations as high priority and issue expedited decisions, similar to the way the agency currently handles disability claims from Wounded Warriors.

"Our veterans have sacrificed so much for our country and it is only right that we ensure they have timely access to the disability benefits they may be eligible for and deserve," said Acting Commissioner Colvin. "Social Security worked with Veterans Affairs to identify those veterans with disabilities who have a high probability of also meeting our definition of disability. I am proud of our collaboration and happy to announce this new service for America's vets."

In order to receive the expedited service, veterans must tell Social Security they have a VA disability compensation rating of 100% P&T and show proof of their disability rating with their VA Notification Letter.

The VA rating only expedites Social Security disability claims processing and does not guarantee an approval for Social Security disability benefits. These veterans must still meet the strict eligibility requirements for a disability allowance. Social Security plans to launch the expedited process in **mid-March**.
