Sentinel Ryan Sykes was recently honored on July 1st, 2015 at the Danville Veterans Memorial Hall as California Assembly District 16's Veteran of the Year. He was awarded this honor by California State Assemblywoman, Catharine Baker who recognized Ryan's achievements as a member of the US Navy and those following his retirement from the Armed Forces after a severe injury in Afghanistan nearly cost him his life. Despite the

many challenges that come with a traumatic brain injury, Ryan has not allowed himself to be held back by his need for a wheelchair but has pushed forward, taking every opportunity to live life. Since his injury, he has participated in bike races, tough mudders, skydiving, rock climbing and white water rafting.







Reward Upgraded in All Wars Memorial Vandalism

\$12,000 offered for Info on those responsible for graffiti at Memorial

The investigation into the June 8, 2015 vandalism at the All Wars Memorial at Oak Hill Park continues as police seek to speak to persons of interest seen in video taken at the park. An initial reward of \$6,500 was offered for information leading to the arrest and conviction of those responsible. Community Organizations have come forward to offer additional funds, bringing the reward total up to \$12,000.

An image pulled from cameras at Oak Hill Park (attached) show a pair of subjects walking in the direction of the memorial at around 3:30 a.m. on Monday, June 8, 2015. Police Chief Steve Simpkins is asking residents to look again at the image and contact police with any information.


