


Gary Villalba Dedicated Service Award to be Presented at Holiday Dinner + Veteran & Volunteer of the Year

The Veteran's community of Pleasanton has joined together with the City of Pleasanton to construct a Veterans Memorial in Pioneer Cemetery. The City has generously allocated land for the memorial. The Harrington family has graciously provided \$40,000. seed money for the project. The Veteran community committed to raise the majority of the funds to complete the project. Early estimates are: \$65,000.+

As approved, the memorial will include six 20-foot tall flagpoles, one for each of the services and the Merchant Marine; one 25 foot flagpole to fly the American flag and the MIA/POW flag, a large center granite platform, a bronze sculpture of a soldier kneeling, & one red granite star with an emblem of one of the services at each point. The six service flagpoles will include a monolith depicting scenes from the history of the service. The names, ranks, & theater of service of Pleasanton veterans killed or missing-in-action will be on the granite platform.
