RYAN SYKES 16TH ASSEMBLY DISTRICT Veteran of the Year Ryan Sykes joined the United States Navy soon after graduating from high school in 2000. He was initially stationed in South Florida and served as the Navy and Marine Corps Senior Analyst for Caribbean, El Salvador, Guatemala, and Colombia.

Following the events of 9/11, Sykes volunteered for a position as a Special Warfare Intelligence Analyst in Virginia. His deployments included Africa, Iraq, and Afghanistan on multiple occasions. He was awarded a Bronze Star for his work in Iraq and Afghanistan.

After an injury in Afghanistan almost cost him his life, Sykes left the military and was accepted into the Sentinels of Freedom Scholarship Foundation. He has focused on rehabilitating from his injury sustained overseas and continues to push himself physically by participating in bike races, skydiving, white water rafting, and rack climbing, even though his disabilities have forced him into a wheelchair.

He is a member of the Dougherty Valley San Ramon Rotary Club and seeks to inspire and mentor others who have disabilities and encourage them to continue pursuing their dreams and goals just as he has done.



Reward Issued for Vandalism

Graffiti found at All Wars Memorial on Monday morning

Extensive graffiti was found on pavement, stone paths and granite benches at the All Warz Memorial in Danville on the morning of Monday, June 8. Danville Police investigators believe the vandalism occurred late Bunday evening.

The All Wars Memorial, located at Oale Hill Park in Darville, is a memorial dedicated to all who served in American wars. Maintained by the Town of Darville in collaboration with the All Wars Memorial Foundation, the sits features bronse figures, walking paths, stone walls and a historical quotation wall. Vandals used black and red spray paint to deface the areas around the memorial. Photoe of the vandalism are attached.

The Town of Danville and private donors have issued a combined 56,500 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator. "The All Wars Memorial is dedicated to honoring the men and women who served our country," said Police Chief Steve Simpleins. "We hope that this reward will help lead our investigators find out who committed this disgraceful crime."

A NEW PROGRAM TO CONNECT VETERANS WITH GUITARS

Organization Overview

Guitars4Vets is a Federally registered 501(C)(3) notfor-profit organization, headquartered in Milwaukee with chapters in 25 states. All chapters are affiliated with VA facilities. The two East Bay chapters are in Livermore and Martinez.

The organization is dedicated to sharing the healing power of music with Veterans dealing with combat related physical and/or emotional stress.

It pursues its mission by



providing qualified Veterans with guitars and private guitar instruction, consisting of ten weekly one-**hour sessions structured to meet each individual's abilities and challenges.**

A practice guitar is provided for use during the 10 weeks, and, upon completion of the program, each Veteran is presented with a new acoustic guitar with a gig-bag, tuner, capo, stand and strap. Additionally, monthly group sessions are offered to all past students to provide ongoing instruction and encouragement.

In 2014, 303 Veterans completed the G4V program and received the new "guitar bundle."


