Film follows work of tomb guards

Livermore officer to host local screenings of The Unknowns'


The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery has been guarded 24 hours a day, every day, since July 2, 1937, by Tomb Guard sentinels, members of the 3rd U.S. Infantry Regiment, also known as the Old Guard.

Visitors may know little about their commitment, training and experiences, nor much about the tomb itself. That may change through a new documen-tary, "The Unknowns," that tells the story through the eyes of former sentinel Ethan Morse.

Morse, who spent 18 months as a sentinel, crested the film, wanting to share his story with Americans. The documentary is being shown nationwide, with two screenings in Brentwood hosted by fellow sentinel and Livermore police officer Stephen Sho-deen, who lives in Brentwood

A first screening Monday at Brentwood 14 IMAX Memorial Day - is sold out, but Shodeen has arranged for a second screening on Fing Day, June 14.

'I am a former sentinel from the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, serving from in recognizing the honor seven- to nine-month train-

1991 to 1995; that was one of my duty assignments while I was in the United States Army on active duty," Sho-deen said. "I'm hosting this because a lot of people are going to get a first-time look at the training and lifestyle of a sentinel. This documentary covers what they go through and what they dedicate to complete the training and the duty to become a sentinel."

Many people never see Arlington National Cem-etery or the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and both Morse and Shodeen believe that experience is integral

due to those buried there. Seeing "The Unknowns" is a step toward that recognition.

The film follows men, like Shodeen, as they prog-ress through the intense

ing program to earn their Tomb Guard identification badges. The instruction includes three components: knowledge, the uniform and outside performance. Tests must be passed at each level.

During the knowledge section Shodeen had to memorize facts about the history of the tomb, the Old Guard, and Arlington Cem-

etery. "Memories of my time lecting and as a sentinel are lasting and that's why I want to help Ethan Morris share "The Unknowns' documentary with everybody," Shodeen said.

In the film "THE UN-KNOWNS" you witness behind the scenes, never seen before view of volunteers from the U.S.

Army's most elite cer-

emonial unit taking on the intense training cycle at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery. Take the journey with

the 'New Men' as they

progress through a strict gauntlet of instruction, correction, & the endless pursuit of perfection. Watch as these soldiers are exposed to the rich history & honorable traditions of the brotherhood of Sentinels who quard the Tomb. Thank you Steve

Large Number of Currently Serving Returning to Contra Costa County County Veterans Service Office Expands Serves / Hours

Our Contra Costa County Veterans Service Office reported that Army One Source has compiled data on Contra Costa County (and other counties as well). This data is available online at <u>http://www.aosresourcecenter.com/data/search-data-maps</u> When reviewing estimated enlisted separations from service from 4/1/15 to 1/31/17 & this is what the data shows:

West County: 53 of 301 total enlisted military separations or 18% Central County (Concord, Walnut Creek, Pleasant Hill, LaMorinda): 98 of 301 or 32% South County (Alamo, Danville, San Ramon): 29 of 301 or 10% East County (Pittsburg & East): 117 of 301 or 39% Unknown: 4 of 301 or 1%

California Veteran Driver License & I D Card

As a Veteran - you can obtain a DMV "Veteran" designation on your Driver's License

The California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and the California Department of Veterans Affairs (CalVet) has a new program honoring Veterans & recognizes the military service by allowing them to apply for a "Veteran" designation on California driver licenses & identification (ID) cards.

All Veterans are encouraged to contact our local Contra Costa County Veteran Service Office in Martinez or one of their outstations to start the process. In addition, Veterans can learn about "earned benefits" from their military service. A "Veteran" designation on a California Driver's License or ID Card will aid Veterans show their status as a certified Veteran & take advantage of businesses proving offers and/or discounts to Veterans.

How to obtain your "Veteran" designation for a driver license or ID card - It's easy:

- Get Records. Find your military discharge certificate (DD214). If you need assistance obtaining your military records, then contact our County Veteran Service Officer (CVSO) in Martinez.
- Visit any Contra Costa County Veteran Service Office. Take your DD214 and government identification to the CVSO to obtain your <u>Veteran Status Verification Form</u>. For faster CVSO service, you can contact our local CVSO by calling 925/313-1481 to find out locations & hours of CVSO outstations, and their main Contra Costa County office is in Martinez
- Visit Any DMV. Go online or call DMV for an appointment. Then bring your <u>Veteran Status Veri-</u> fication Form to any DMV field office. Pay any application fees, in addition to a \$5.00 Veteran designation fee, and complete all application & testing requirements. To schedule an appointment at a DMV office, visit <u>www.dmv.ca.gov</u> or call 800-777-0133.


