Wear your shirt - see "T.J." if you need one... & have the best time distributing free Flags to a very appreciative crowd! Note: We have been requested to muster at 0730 at the south end of SRVHS - Love & Railroad. Look for the 'white' shirts! The Parade Kicks-off at 0900 Hrs. Takes 30 minutes.

Parking becomes more difficult the later you arrive & street close early. Plan accordingly & muster on-time. This event is worth it!

Veterans To Get Exchange Privledges

Honorably discharged veterans are getting limited online military exchange shopping privileges as of November 11, 2017.

The Defense Department announced the change Jan. 13, calling it a way to reward those who served their country and generate funds for the morale, welfare & recreation (MWR) activities. The privilege will not extend to purchase of uniforms, tobacco or alcohol products.

DoD views it as a win-win in that it is expected to bolster the exchanges' online retail operations, helping them develop inventory and improve service.



TYLER ANDERSON STAFF SERGEANT, US ARMY

Tyler deployed to Afghanistan twice. He served as a rifleman, sniper, grenadier, machine gunner, team leader, and squad leader. While conducting combat operations in 2010, Tyler stepped on an improvised exposive devise (IED) attached to a jug of homemade explosives, causing him to lose his left leg and index finger. He underwent several months of recovery and learned to use a prosthetic leg. Not one to let his injuries get the best of him, Tyler now lives an active lifestyle and participates in scuba diving, wakeboarding, CrossFit, and Brazilian jiu-jitsu.

Tyler graduated with a bachelor's degree in integrated studies with a focus in business and Spanish, all while working full-time as an intelligence analyst with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA). Currently, he works as a SWAT Officer and was recently accepted to attend the FBI Academy to become a special agent.


