Wear your white polo shirt - see “T.J.” if you need one... & have the best time distributing free Flags to a very appreciative crowd!

Note: We have been requested to muster at 0730 at the south end of SRVHS - Love & Railroad. Look for the ‘white’ shirts! The Parade Kicks-off at 0900 Hrs. Takes 30 minutes & we go through before it gets too hot.

Parking becomes more difficult the later you arrive & street close early. Plan accordingly & muster on-time. Suggested route to parking. El Cerro - right Danville Blvd - left Del Amigo - left Verona - left Love to SRVHS parking on left. This event is worth it!

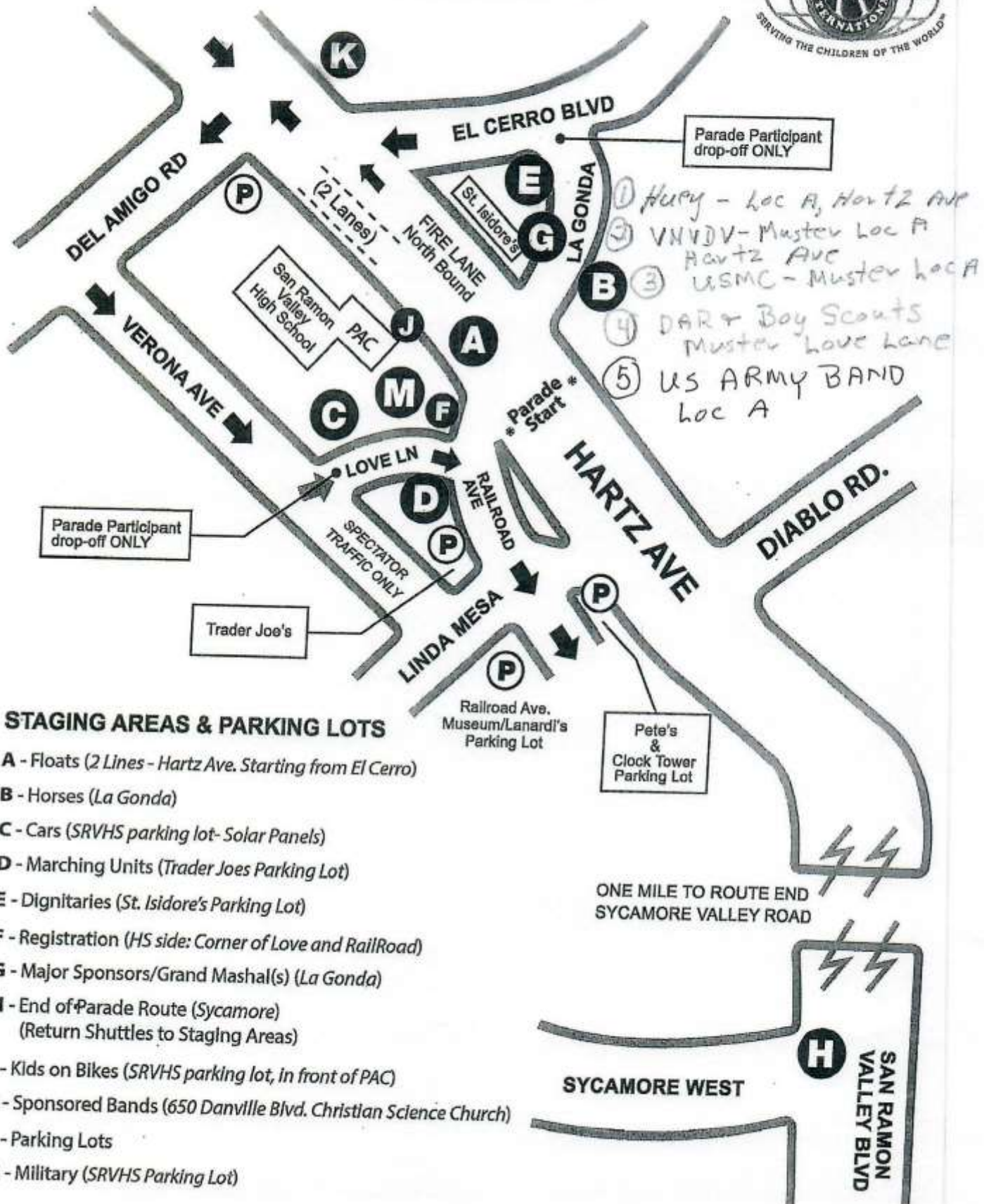

VOLUNTEERS FOR SET-UP - PARTICIPATION IN THE FOUR DAY PROGRAM SEPTEMBER 13 - 16 - TEAR DOWN WILL BE REQUIRED

A complete list of volunteer areas and requirements will be listed on the EBSD website. All volunteers must register on-line. No on-site volunteer registration is permitted.

The 2018 East Bay Stand Down (EBSD) is scheduled for September 13 through 16, 2018 at Alameda County Fair Grounds in Pleasanton - *the original four-day Stand Down in the U.S.*

All meetings for EBSD are Open - Public Community Information & Planning Meetings & held on the second Tuesday of each month. Locations vary in the East Bay - *so always check the website for latest information on EBSD meetings & wish list needs.* The next public community meeting is **TUESDAY - JULY 10th at 1800 Hrs. (P.M.)** at **VETERANS MEMORIAL BUILDING of San Ramon Valley** - 400 Hartz Avenue in Danville, CA.

Community organizations, clubs, businesses, churches & interested individuals are encouraged to find out more about how you might be able to assist in this major community effort to end homelessness for our military Veterans. As months get closer to the event date - final meetings usually take place at the Alameda Fairgrounds to aid volunteers in becoming familiar with the event location. **NOTE:** EBSD public - monthly planning meetings is an excellent venue to show your support & present your 2018 **"Sponsorship Donation Checks."** Major Sponsorship begins at **\$5,000.00 & "Tent Sponsorship" is \$500 for non-profit organizations & \$1,000. for Corporations.** All groups Sponsoring Meals during the four-day event are coordinated with Food Services & Executive Board. **NOTE:** *All EBSD donation checks should be made payable to - Diablo Valley Veterans Foundation, a 501(c)3 funding EBSD.*

The EBSD "Executive Board" meets prior to each public meeting at 1700 (P.M.) at the same location as the community / public meetings. We respectfully request all planning meeting attendees wait until P.M. before entering allowing the Executive Board to complete their business meeting prior to the scheduled start of public meetings. *We are all volunteers & can always use help setting up chairs & putting them away.*

Each Planning Meeting has a **"Sign-In"** sheet requesting: Your Name - Organization you are representing - Your Mobile Phone & your best E-Mail contact address & if you attend on a regular basis - this information will be pre-typed & you need to check to see if all data is correct. Collection of information will allow Executive Board Members **& Coordinators to contact you personally, if necessary between meetings. This listing is kept "confidential" & not shared with any except those mentioned above.** At your first planning meeting - you will be requested to provide the information above.

If you have questions - about anything - the monthly planning meetings - locations or times - **always check the EBSD website at: www.EastBayStandDown.org** The official 2018 **"Volunteer Sign-Up"** will NOT be available online until **July 16th** & completed online.

Signing-in at the monthly planning meetings DOES NOT register you as a Volunteer at EBSD. This is a separate process. Again - check the EBSD website on a regular basis for additional information. Thank you for your support of East Bay Stand Down 2018. Help spread the word - get other groups interested in EBSD.

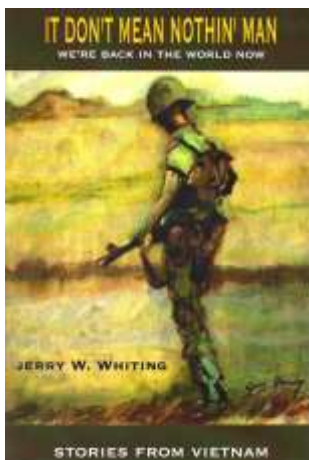

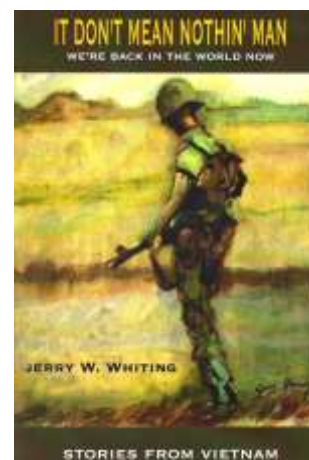

On display are original Nurse and Red Cross uniforms, medical equipment, therapy artifacts, and photos.

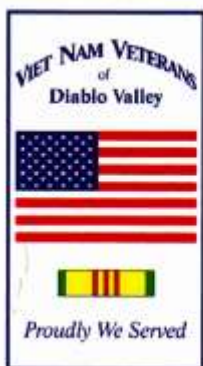

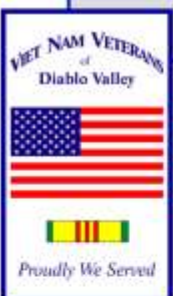
