"MIDWAY - 2019 Version"

This newer version of MIDWAY, released in 2019 is a technically accurate production starring Patrick Evans and Luke Wilson. It is an expansive production covering Pearl Harbor, Doo-little's raid on Tokyo and the Battle of Midway itself. One of the interesting details is the "Walk-down" where crew members form a line and walk the length of the carrier deck while picking up loose nuts, bolts and debris. One distracting person in the casting, however, is Woody Harrelson who plays Admiral Chester Nimitz. It is difficult to take the goofy bartender from Cheers seriously.

While this reviewer still prefers the 1976 version with Charlton Heston and Henry Fonda, Director Roland Emmerich does a fair job of depicting one of the biggest battles in naval history.


