





Robert Fish, Naval Midshipman 1966

Robert Fish graduated from high school in Orlando, FL in 1966 and attended the University of Virginia on a Naval ROTC scholarship.

After college, he enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps stationed at the USMC Western Pacific data center, Okinawa managing IBM computer systems supplying the Vietnam war effort.

After being honorably discharged in 1971, he remained in the information technology field, holding increasingly important positions at Blue Cross, Safeway Stores, Wells Fargo Bank and Bank of America.

In 1984, he joined his first high tech Silicon Valley startup company, Network Equipment Technologies (NET). In 1985, during the Reagan era, Bob was the program manager for the modernization of the White House communications system. Following the Challenger space shuttle disaster, he became involved with the DoD and worked on a number of strategic national intelligence programs. Bob received a USAF commendation for his activities in the Desert Storm/Shield war.

In 2000, Bob joined the Board of Trustees of the USS Hornet Museum, a highly decorated WWII aircraft carrier located in Alameda, CA.

He is a recognized national authority on the Navy's role in the recovery of the 1960's NASA manned space-flights. He is also the creator of the award winning "Apollo 11 spacecraft recovery exhibit" on board the USS Hornet museum and is a published author of the highly acclaimed book "Hornet Plus Three" about the recovery of Apollo 11.

Bob has lived in Danville for 30 years, is married and has one son.

### Don't get the FLU - Get Your FLU Shot this month!

### No-cost flu shots available for enrolled Veterans

Free flu shots start on September 16, 2022, at all VA Northern California Health Care System locations. Flu shots can prevent or reduce flu symptoms.

#### Why should I get a flu shot?

During the COVID-19 pandemic, it is especially important for all of us to do our part to help reduce the spread of the flu in our communities. A flu shot is a safe way to help protect yourself and those around you from getting sick and having complications from flu. You should get an updated flu shot every year. The flu shot neither prevents nor causes COVID-19. As a reminder, the flu shot cannot cause a flu-illness, and the vaccine we use does not contain any live virus. Visit the VHA Public Health website for more information.

Routine vaccination prevents illnesses that lead to unnecessary medical visits and hospitalizations.

If you have already received the COVID-19 and/or flu vaccine outside of the VA, provide your nurse with the documentation (date/location), so your records will be updated.

#### Enrolled Veterans get a no-cost flu shot at Martinez Outpatient Clinic

#### **During Scheduled Appointments**

Enrolled Veterans can request a flu shot during most scheduled appointments. Ask the provider or clerk about flu shots when scheduling an appointment.

#### **Walk-In Vaccination Clinics**

Flu shots are being offered on a walk-in basis at the Martinez, VA Clinic.

Clinics are open to dogs and cats belonging to Veterans of any era (up to two pets per visit). No non-military civilians will be accepted. Clients must furnish valid military identification at the time of check-in.

Acceptable forms of military identification include military I.D. card, VA health identification card, discharge paperwork with matching photo identification, or Department of Defense Form 214 with matching photo identification.

#### What Services Does ARF's Clinic Offer to Veterans?

Complimentary services provided include:

- Annual wellness exam
- Vaccines
- Heartworm testing for dogs
- FeLV/FIV testing for cats
- Year-round flea, tick, and parasite preventative products
- Spay and neuter (by appointment, clients must visit our wellness clinic for exam first)



Where do I Go for My Appointment?

Our Veterans clinic entrance can be found past the main adoption entrance and spay/neuter clinic entrance,

What Can I Expect from My Appointment?

If you are a new client, your Veterans' ID will be checked, and you will be given an information form to fill out about your pet(s). Dogs must be on leash and under control at all times. Cats must be in carriers.

Are There Limits on How Many Pets Can be Seen?

In order to serve as many Veterans as possible, we limit services to two pets per household per clinic and we provide services to a lifetime maximum of six pets per veterans' household.


