I am also happy to report that we are making good progress on developing a 5 Year Transition Plan for VNVDV. At the latest Board Meeting Six Working Committees were set up with leaders responsible to research the future of each area of our organization. The following are the Committees and the heads of each Committee:

1. MONTHLY MEMBER MEETINGS- Steven Burchik & Eric Ardell. Objective- Evaluate location and timing.

2. FUNDRAISING PROJECTS- Jim Hill. Objective- Develop a viability and revenue forecast.

3. COMMUNITY MANPOWER SUPPORT- John Reese & John "TJ" Trujillo. Objective- Develop manpower projections for Parades, Color Guards, etc.

4. COMMUNITY FINANCIAL SUPPORT- Slatts. Objective- Develop a 5 Year forecast of funds available and how we allocate contributions to community groups.

5. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM- Bill Green & Jim Murphy. Objective- implement and manage a new scholarship program.

6. TRANSITION TO YOUNGER VETS or DISBAND- Dennis Giacovelli. Objective- Review alternatives to continuing in the future and define triggers or milestones that will necessitate the need to disband (probably later than 5 years).

These Committees welcome member participation. If you see an area of interest in this list contact the head of the Committee and let them know that you would like to help.

One great piece of news is that the Scholarship Committee has already been working on this project for many months and is announcing the launch of the Spring 2023 Scholarship Program. See the details elsewhere in this Newsletter.

We are committed to having a minimum of 50 people at the dinner to avoid a financial penalty. Please try to make a point of participating at this gathering of fellow veterans.

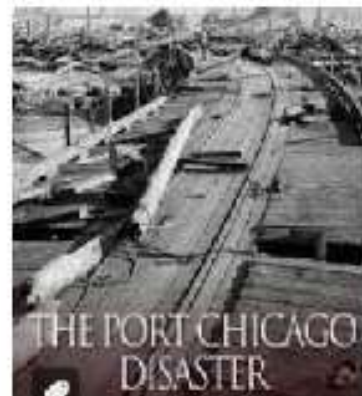

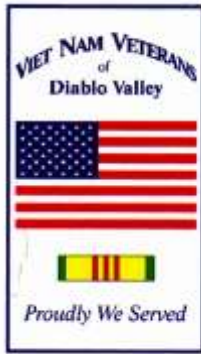
