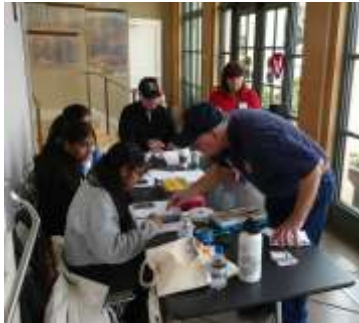

**Protect Yourself and Those you Love**

- ▶ Desperate people do desperate things, NEVER forget that
- ▶ Avoid such people and it is absolutely OK to be a bit paranoid when you see people that make you nervous at all.
- ▶ Pay attention to the "little hairs on the back of your neck" when you get that "feeling" that something or someone is just not right
- ▶ Report suspicious/scary events to the police
- ▶ If someone threatens you with a gun, that is SCARY – give them what they want and protect yourself! so you can survive the scary event
- ▶ Do not confront scary people, it is not worth it – get to a safe place and report the problem to the police, they get paid to do that work.

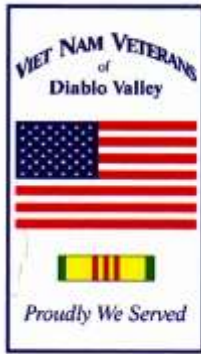
