

## **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

The Viet Nam Veterans of Diablo Valley are proud to support educational growth opportunities for veteran related students in our community. Our organization has established a scholarship program to provide some financial assistance to these students in their pursuit for a higher education. We encourage all who qualify to apply.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Any child or grandchild of an active VNVDV member in good standing is eligible to apply.
- Scholarship is a onetime issue. This is not a renewable grant
- Application submissions limited to 2025 graduating High School Seniors and/or current trade or college academic students pursing a certificate or degree.
- Copy of all High School and/or college related academic transcripts
- Copy of letter of acceptance or enrollment confirmation to a two (2 ) or four (4 ) year college/university or accredited trade school.
- Essay - Applicants must submit a 500-1000 word essay based on the theme "The American Veteran".
- Essays will be reviewed and scholarship grants will be awarded by an independent panel of U.S, Military Veterans.
- Four (4) \$1000. Individual Scholarship grants will be awarded. One award per person.
- Awarded recipients and their family will be invited to a future VNVDV reception as our guests and will be honored and acknowledged by our members.
- **Applications, transcripts and essays must be received by May 15, 2025**




