

Veterans Memorial Building turns 100

The Veterans Memorial Building of San Ramon Valley, located in downtown Danville, will be turning 100 years old on April 2, 2025. To mark the event, the Veterans and the Community, will be holding a Centennial Party on March 30, 2025. The 1920's themed event will include an open house-museum showcasing the Veterans Building as well as life in the United States during the 20's. The day will be filled with food, entertainment and educational activities.

To help in that effort, the Planning Committee is putting out the call to everyone to please look in your attic, basement, photo albums, etc., for pictures of the Veterans Building and of activities that took place in the building throughout its history. Besides a home for Veterans, the building has been used for the Chamber of Commerce office, Justice of the Peace court, County Supervisor's office, Red Cross, Farm Bureau, Boy Scouts, recreational, drama and exercise classes, youth activities, business and social events, post office, voting location, dances, performances, and many other uses.
